





Community enCompass

Community enCompass has a one-year service opportunity available for an Ameri-Corps State & National member starting in September. The member will serve at Allen Avenue Christian Reformed Church & Angell Neighbors for Change, with a primary focus on youth mentoring. The member will strengthen the connections between neighbors, churches, and neighborhood groups through Asset Based Community Development, with a primary focus on developing relationships with core city youth through after school programs, summer camps, and various seasonal events throughout the year. Start-date is September 1st! **Deadline to apply is Monday August 1st. Candidate interviews are August 8-12th.** This is a one-year commitment to national service, that provides a bi-weekly stipend with benefits, and requires dedicated, committed candidates. It is not a volunteer position, nor a guarantee of employment with Community enCompass following the member's term of service.
