Late responses will not be considered. Bidders are responsible for ensuring that the following identifying information appears on the outside of each envelope: **SEALED PROPOSAL – BID NAME**, your company/organization name, date due, and time due. If a delivery service is used which prohibits such markings on their envelope or package, this information must be placed on the outside of the interior envelope or package. The City of Muskegon reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to accept the bid it feels is in the best interest of the City. Bid Name: Highway Maintenance Materials -

(include any and all surcharges, such as fuel and delivery charges)

85,000 gallons Calcium Chloride 38% spread (road brine)

15,000 gallons Calcium Chloride 32% stored (winter salting)

Payment for these items will be by the gallon, but in no case will the City pay for more than the maximum application rate, or the rate of applications established at the time of application. Bidders shall quote a price for spreading and a price for filling storage tank at the Public Service Building, 1350 E. Keating Avenue.

200 tons Bituminous Asphalt 4:12, 3C-Base

1,000 tons Bituminous Asphalt 4:12, 4C-Top

These items shall be picked up at the supplier's yards. Distance to the yards will be considered in determining low bid.

**POLICY REGARDING LOCAL PREFERENCE
PURCHASING/CONTRACTING**

2005-34(j)

A. Purpose

To establish parameters in order for the City Commission to give local preference consideration for City contracts and purchases.

B. Local Preference Policy


The City Commission may give local preference on purchases and contracts to local businesses when the lowest local business bid/price is within 1% or less of the lowest non.-local bid. In cases where the total cost is expected to exceed \$1 million, the City Commission will be consulted on whether local preference may apply, prior to soliciting bids. Additionally, for the purposes of this policy, "local" shall mean a business with a business location in the City of Muskegon.
