POLICY REGARDING LOCAL PREFERENCE PURCHASING/CONTRACTING

2005-34(j)

A. Purpose

To establish parameters in order for the City Commission to give local preference consideration for City contracts and purchases.

B. Local Preference Policy


The City Commission may give local preference on purchases and contracts to local businesses when the lowest local business bid/price is within 1% or less of the lowest non.-local bid. In cases where the total cost is expected to exceed \$1 million, the City Commission will be consulted on whether local preference may apply, prior to soliciting bids. Additionally, for the purposes of this policy, "local" shall mean a business with a business location in the City of Muskegon.
