

A list of DDA accomplishments/expenditures

1. Final bond payments were made in 2015 for the \$1 million issuance from 1989 and in 2018 for the \$2.045 million issuance refunded in 2011.
2. The DDA has supported the redevelopment of the city's L.C Walker Arena (renamed Mercy Health Arena) with \$1 million to help in funding new concourse, new restrooms, a new roof and HAVC equipment.
3. The DDA is in the process of paying off a \$1 million debt to Muskegon County from the Muskegon Mall Era. Initial payments were made in 2019-20 budget and will be completed in 2020-21 budget.
4. The DDA joined the Muskegon Business Improvement District and the Downtown Muskegon Development Corp. in 2019 to resurface the DMDC Morris Street Parking Lots for \$60,000. The DDA contributed \$20,000.
5. Upon retirement of the Muskegon Mall Era bonds, the DDA has taken its role in leading downtown management – economic development, events, marketing and promotion. The DDA merged with Downtown Muskegon Mall and agreed to have the city of Muskegon provide staff services to the DOA.
