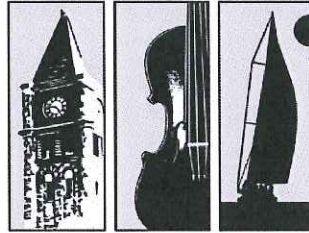

 - A: **Yes, survey should provide inverts and connectivity for storm and sanitary structures within the survey limits.**
