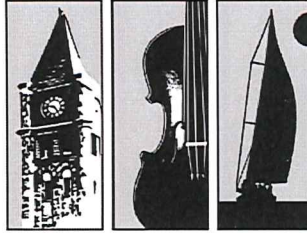

Prospective Bidders;


The following requirements are hereby formally added to City of Muskegon Contract SP-91914 which includes work to clean and paint two (2) railroad bridges over Seaway Drive. These topics will also be discussed at the optional pre-bid meeting on January 17th, 2020.

The contract will require obtaining a Right-of-Entry Permit from the railroad for completion of the project work. The following responsibilities are hereby assigned relative to this contract:

- Upon award of project the City of Muskegon will apply for and obtain the required right-of-entry permit from the railroad to facilitate the project construction.
- The awarded Contractor will be responsible to assist by providing necessary details required for the permit application and to comply with all the terms of the issued permit.
- The awarded Contractor will be responsible to provide the required insurance. Specific requirements will be listed in the permit, typical requirements from similar projects are as follows:
 - Public Liability or Commercial General Liability Insurance (Single - \$2M / Aggregate - \$6M)
 - Commercial Automobile Insurance (Single - \$1M)
 - Statutory Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Insurance (Minimum - \$1M)
 - Railroad Protective Liability Insurance (Single - \$2M / Aggregate - \$6M)
